Employment Services



As a reminder, HCBS Employment Services are most often not able to be requested first since Medicaid is payor of last resort. Per service definitions, there's guidance as to when one of the following referrals need to be attempted first:

- Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR)
 - When a participant is being referred to OVR, encourage benefits counseling.
 OVR can assist as they have the same requirements to attempt WIPA.
- Ticket to Work Helpline Work Incentives Planning and Assistance Program (WIPA)
 - Note: The helpline rep will determine eligibility (priority categories) based on responses from the participant. If the rep says to give a call when closer to employment, this is verification that the participant is not eligible for WIPA. Once this is documented in the service plan, SCs can move forward in the process to request HCBS Benefits Counseling auth which includes confirmation of referral acceptance by Employment Services Provider.
- PA CareerLink® Always encourage and promote, even alongside other services.

ACHIEVA Family Trust Employment and Benefits Counseling Program



- About: Our program assists individuals with disabilities who are working or seeking employment understand how that earned (employment) income will impact essential government benefits, such as Social Security, Medicaid, Waiver, HUD, SNAP, etc. Our program helps identify and apply applicable Work Incentives as a method to reduce "Countable Income", which will enable the individual to maintain crucial means-tested and needs-based benefits while working. In addition, the Achieva Family Trust's EBC program offers General Benefits Counseling services, which includes fielding basic benefits questions, appeal and overpayment guidance, government benefit/services application assistance, Special Needs Trust, PA ABLE & Future Planning education and guidance and more.

- About: The philosophy of Beechwood NeuroRehab is to provide comprehensive rehabilitation to adults with acquired brain injury incorporating innovative treatment concepts along with the application of technology and research. Beechwood NeuroRehab employs a person-centered, transdisciplinary approach emphasizing development of compensatory strategies to maximize the individual's ability to participate in meaningful roles within a community setting. The Supported Employment model is designed to provide the individual with the necessary support, tools and guidance to obtain and maintain competitive employment in the community. Initial job development helps find the best vocational match for the person's strengths, and once placed in a job, job coaching helps develop the strategies needed for success. Job coaching fades into follow-along services which provide support for job retention.

Roads to Freedom / CILNCP



• About: The "Ticket to Work" (TTW) incentive was designed by the Social Security Administration to remove the barriers that beneficiaries of SSI and SSDI face returning to work. TTW allows individuals to maintain the availability of their health care services and medical coverage when returning to work, eliminates the "Medical Disability Review" while seeking employment, and pays for free employment services offered by an Employment Network of their choice. Under TTW Social Security provides beneficiaries, between the ages of 18-64, with a Ticket that they may use to assign it to an Employment Network (EN). CILNCP is an approved Employment Network which offers: Job searching assistance, Resume preparation, Interview skills, Job postings, Vocational counseling, Employment support systems, Assistance with job accommodations, Job coaching support. The ultimate goal of CIL's TTW program is to assist beneficiaries to become self-sufficient through employment, and thereby no longer be dependent on cash benefits.
